1. On the day, contestants are provided with one disposable camera per team and a list of 20 photographs to produce within four hours. The photos are divided into three categories: The Screenplay requires contestants to photograph themselves in scenarios which may involve bemused civil servants, unsuspecting pedestrians, or confused tourists; Locations requires contestants to solve riddles in order to find specific places to be photographed in; and Props Department requires contestants to find rare or unusual items to be photographed with.
2. Once the shoot is complete, the films are processed for judging and mounted for exhibition during the celebration which follows.
3. Judging is based on the time taken to complete the hunt and the odds of attaining each shot. Bonus points are earned for a speedy completion. No aesthetic considerations are made, except for the "Judge's Choice" awards. The winning team is that which earns the highest number of points. In the case of a tie, the team with the greatest number of points and the highest number of qualifying photos, wins. In case of an absolute tie, the team with the highest number of points and qualifying photos and which completed the hunt in the least amount of time, wins.
4. The decision of the judges is final and binding. Prizes are as awarded and will be handed out on the evening. Some restrictions may apply.
5. Women in Film & Video Vancouver reserves the right to digitize and publish select photographs from the event for archival and promotional use.
6. Companies are welcome to form more than one team. Colleagues are encouraged to challenge each other at the office, on location, or while queuing at the catering truck.
7. Individual registration is not permitted. Have you no friends?
